- Medium-weight yarn (worsted weight) in your desired color - Crochet hook (size recommended on yarn label) - Yarn needle - Scissors - Stuffing
material (polyester fiberfill or cotton balls) - Embroidery floss or yarn for details (e.g., nose, eyes, mouth)


## Step-by-Step Crochet Pattern Bear Instructions

## Part 1: Crocheting the Head

1. Begin by making a magic ring. 2. Chain 2 (counts as a double crochet).
2. Work 6 double crochets (dc) into the ring. 4. Pull the ring tight to form a circle. 5. Join with a slip stitch (sl st) to the first dc.

## Part 2: Increasing for the Head

1. Round 2: Chain 2, work 2 dc in each dc around. (12 dc) 2. Round 3: Chain 2, *dc in the next dc, 2 dc in the next dc*. Repeat * around. (18 dc) 3. Round 4: Chain 2, *dc in the next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next dc*. Repeat * around. (24 dc) 4. Round 5: Chain 2, *dc in the next 3 dc , 2 dc in the next dc*. Repeat * around. (30 dc)

## Part 3: Shaping the Head

1. Round 6: Chain 2, *dc in the next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next dc*. Repeat * around. (36 dc) 2. Round 7-11: Chain 2, dc in each dc around. (36 dc) 3. Round 12: Chain 2, *dc in the next $5 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next dc*. Repeat * around. (42 dc) 4. Round 13-16: Chain 2, dc in each dc around. (42 dc) 5. Round 17: Chain 2, *dc in the next $6 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next dc*. Repeat * around. (48 dc)

## Part 4: Finishing the Head

1. Round 18-21: Chain 2, dc in each dc around. (48 dc) 2. Stuff the head lightly with filling. 3. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. 4. Use the yarn needle to sew the head closed.

## Part 5: Crocheting the Body

1. Make a magic ring. 2. Chain 2 , work 6 dc into the ring. 3. Pull the ring tight to form a circle. 4. Join with a sl st to the first dc.

## Part 6: Increasing for the Body

1. Round 2: Chain 2, 2 dc in each dc around. (12 dc) 2. Round 3: Chain 2, *dc in the next dc, 2 dc in the next dc*. Repeat * around. (18 dc) 3. Round 4: Chain 2, *dc in the next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next dc*. Repeat * around. (24 dc) 4. Round 5: Chain 2, *dc in the next 3 dc, 2 dc in the next dc*. Repeat * around. (30 dc)

## Part 7: Shaping the Body

1. Round 6: Chain 2, *dc in the next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next dc*. Repeat * around. (36 dc) 2. Round 7-11: Chain 2, dc in each dc around. (36 dc) 3. Round 12: Chain 2, *dc in the next $5 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next dc*. Repeat * around. (42 dc) 4. Round 13-16: Chain 2, dc in each dc around. (42 dc) 5. Round 17: Chain 2, *dc in the next $6 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next dc*. Repeat * around. (48 dc)

## Part 8: Finishing the Body

1. Round 18-21: Chain 2, dc in each dc around. (48 dc) 2. Stuff the body lightly with filling. 3. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. 4. Use the yarn needle to sew the body closed.

## Part 9: Crocheting the Legs

1. Make a magic ring. 2. Chain 2, work 6 dc into the ring. 3. Pull the ring tight to form a circle. 4. Join with a sl st to the first dc.

## Part 10: Increasing for the Legs

1. Round 2: Chain 2, 2 dc in each dc around. (12 dc) 2. Round 3: Chain 2, *dc in the next dc, 2 dc in the next dc*. Repeat * around. (18 dc) 3. Round 4: Chain 2, *dc in the next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next dc*. Repeat * around. (24 dc) 4. Round 5: Chain 2, *dc in the next 3 dc, 2 dc in the next dc*. Repeat * around. (30 dc)

## Part 11: Shaping the Legs

1. Round 6: Chain 2, *dc in the next 4 dc
