Getting Started: Essential Tools and Materials

Easy Crochet Storage Basket Patterns for Beginners

Now that you know the basic crochet stitches, you are ready to start creating your own storage baskets.

Pattern 1: Simple Round Basket

- 1. Make a magic ring.
- 2. Chain 1 and work 6 sc into the magic ring. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc.
- 3. Round 2: Chain 1 and work 2 sc in each sc around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (12 sc)

- 4. Round 3: Chain 1 and work (1 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (18 sc)
- 5. Round 4: Chain 1 and work 1 sc in each sc around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (18 sc)
- 6. Repeat Round 4 until the basket reaches the desired height.
- 7. Finish off the basket by working a round of sc around the rim.

Pattern 2: Oval Basket with Handles

- 1. Chain 20.
- 2. Slip stitch the first and last chain together to form a ring.
- 3. Round 1: Chain 3 (counts as 1 dc), work 2 dc in each chain around.

 Join with a slip stitch to the first dc. (18 dc)
- 4. Round 2-10: Chain 3 and work 1 dc in each dc around. Join with a slip stitch to the first dc. (18 dc)
- 5. For the handles, chain 20 and slip stitch the first and last chain together.
- 6. Attach the handles to the basket by crocheting a few sc around the top of each handle.

Pattern 3: Rectangular Basket

- 1. Chain 20.
- 2. Work 1 sc in the second chain from the hook and in each remaining chain. Turn.
- 3. Chain 1 and work 1 sc in each sc across. Turn.

- 4. Repeat Row 3 until the basket reaches the desired height.
- 5. Finish off the basket by working a round of sc around the rim.

Modern Crochet Storage Basket Patterns

Once you have mastered the basics, you can start exploring more modern crochet storage basket patterns.

Pattern 4: Spiral Basket

- 1. Make a magic ring.
- 2. Chain 1 and work 6 sc into the magic ring. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc.
- 3. Round 2: Chain 1 and work (1 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (12 sc)
- 4. Round 3: Chain 1 and work (2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (18 sc)
- 5. Continue increasing the number of sc in each cluster by 2 in each round.
- 6. When the basket reaches the desired size, work a few rounds of sc around the rim to finish it off.

Pattern 5: Triangle Basket

- 1. Chain 3.
- 2. Slip stitch the first and last chain together to form a ring.
- 3. Round 1: Chain 3, work 2 dc in each chain around. Join with a slip stitch to the first dc. (6 dc)

- 4. Round 2: Chain 3, work 1 dc in the first dc, 2 dc in the next dc around.

 Join with a slip stitch to the first dc. (9 dc)
- 5. Continue increasing the number of dc in each cluster by 1 in each round.
- 6. When the basket reaches the desired size, work a few rounds of sc around the rim to finish it off.

Pattern 6: Hexagon Basket

- 1. Make 6 granny squares.
- 2. Join the granny squares together to form a hexagon.
- 3. Fold up the sides of the hexagon and sew them together to form the basket.

Tips for Crocheting Storage Baskets

- Use a medium-weight yarn that is suitable for crocheting baskets.
- Choose a crochet hook that is the correct size for the yarn you are using.
- Follow the pattern instructions carefully.
- Count your stitches regularly to make sure you are on track.
- Weave in loose ends as you go.
- Block your basket before using it to give it a more polished look.


