To start the game, each player draws 10 cards from the deck. The remaining cards are placed face down in a pile in the center of the table, known as the stock. The top card of the stock pile is turned face up to create the discard pile.

The player who has the lowest score at the end of the game wins.

### **Strategies for Winning Gin Rummy**

- Draw strategically. When drawing cards, consider the cards that you already have and the cards that your opponent is likely to have. 


