**Step 6: Cut the yarn and pull it through the last stitch to secure.**

**Step 7: Weave in any loose ends.**

## **Slouchy Hat Pattern**

The slouchy hat is a stylish and comfortable hat that is perfect for colder weather. It is a bit more challenging to crochet than the basic beanie, but it is still a great pattern for beginners.

**Step 1: Create a slip knot and chain 4.**

Round 9: 60 sc

**Step 5: Once you have reached the desired length for the hat, work one round of sc without increasing.**

**Step 6: Cut the yarn and pull it through the last stitch to secure.**

**Step 7: Weave in any loose ends.**

## **Tips for Choosing Yarn and Supplies**
